The Relevance of the Tongue:

It's the least controllable body part.

James 3:2 We all make many mistakes, but those who control their tongues can also control themselves in every other way.

It's a very small body part with very <u>large impact</u>.

James 3:3 We can make a large horse turn around and go wherever we want by means of a small bit in its mouth.

It does more than any other body part to chart your direction in life.

James 3:4 And a tiny rudder makes a huge ship turn wherever the pilot wants it to go, even though the winds are strong.

The Risks of the Tongue

Its' impact is highly disproportionate.

James 3:5 So also, the tongue is a small thing, but what enormous damage it can do.

Its' impact spreads rapidly.

James 3:5 A tiny spark can set a great forest on fire.

Its' effect reveals one's true character.

James 3:6the tongue ... is full of wickedness that can ruin your whole life. It can turn the entire course of your life into a blazing flame of destruction.....

Its' volatility is incredibly high.

James 3:9 Sometimes it praises our Lord and Father, and sometimes it breaks out into curses against those who have been made in the image of God
