Matthew 16:27 The Son of Man will come again with his Father's glory and with his angels. At that time, he will reward them for what they have done. (NCV)

My <u>belief</u> determines WHERE I spend eternity.
My <u>behavior</u> determines HOW I spend eternity.

1 Cor. 3:8-9 Apollos and I are working as a team, with the same aim, though each of us will be rewarded for his own hard work. [9] We are only God's coworkers. ...

- I. My perspective influences my behavior.
- a) An awareness of God's *personal plan* for me.

1 Cor. 3:10 Because of <u>God's special favor to me</u>, I have laid the foundation like an expert builder.

b) An awareness of <u>my fit</u> in God's BIG picture.

1 Cor. 3:10I have laid the foundation like an expert builder. Now others are building on it.

c) A passion to build Christ's Kingdom, and not my own.

1 Cor. 3:10-11 But whoever is building on this foundation must be very careful. For no one can lay any other foundation than the one we already have-Jesus Christ.

- II. My behavior results from my choices.
- a) I alone am <u>responsible</u> for my choices.

1 Cor. 3:12-13 Now anyone who builds on that foundation may use gold, silver, jewels, wood, hay, or straw. But there is going to come a time of testing at the judgment day to

b) My choices will be tested in terms of <u>eternal values</u>.

1 Cor. 3:13 Everyone's work will be put through the fire to see whether or not it keeps its value.

c) Choices with positive eternal impact result in eternal rewards.

1 Cor. 3:14 If the work survives the fire, that builder will receive a reward. (NLT)

d) God forgives poor choices, but they are still wasted opportunities.

1 Cor. 3:15 But if the work is burned up, the builder will suffer great loss. The builders themselves will be saved, but like someone escaping through a wall of flames.

Matthew 6:1 "Be careful not to do your 'acts of righteousness' before men, to be seen by them. If you do, you will have no reward from your Father in heaven.

2 John 1:8 Watch out that you do not lose what you have worked for, but that you may be rewarded fully.
